In partnership with the NHL Ottawa Senators, and as a member of the Kanata Girls Hockey Association (KGHA), the Ottawa Lady Sens Hockey Club strives to offer a first-class program that ensures our athletes are developed both as elite hockey players and exceptional people. We offer three teams within our high-performance program – U22AA, U18AA, and U15AA – comprising over 50 players aged 13-19.

The goal of the Lady Sens Club is to create an environment and culture around our teams that will support and assist all of our players in continuing to excel at the highest levels. We take great pride in icing a competitive program with character players that reflect the beliefs of integrity, good sportsmanship, and the will to win. We work to develop players who strive for championship habits, have a strong work ethic, and embrace failure as a way to improve. At the same time, we provide widespread understanding of the values of fair play and sportsmanship, the learning of life skills through hockey, and the importance of keeping sport in perspective.

The Lady Sens Organization ensures that our athletes are visible to scouts from American NCAA colleges and Canadian U Sport universities as well as Ontario and Canadian high-performance opportunities. Over the past 10 seasons we have had more than 80 players accept scholarships to play at the post-secondary level. In addition, we have had a number of players advance to the Team Canada program, the CWHL, the NWHL, and the more recent PWHPA.

Our U22AA team is an active member of the Provincial Women's Hockey League (PWHL), which is considered the top amateur women's league in Ontario and one of the most competitive leagues in Canada. This season, due to the Covid-19 pandemic, the Lady Sens U22AA team will compete in a temporary Eastern Regional Division of the OWHL while our U18AA and U15AA teams will play in their respective Regional Divisions. All of our teams will be participating in a number of Showcase Tournaments over the season. We have confidence that all of our members will represent the Lady Sens Hockey Club brand with sportsmanship and class, and that our players will show character and leadership traits expected from high performance athletes.

As with most clubs, we are supported by a number of dedicated coaches, managers, trainers, parents, and volunteers. We wish to thank them all, including the KGHA, for providing the players with this special opportunity.


